



## **ABSTRACT**

Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board - Augmentation of water supply scheme to 708 habitations in Annur, Avinashi and Suler Unions in Coimbatore and Tiruppur Districts with bulk provision to 165 habitations in Tiruppur Union of Tiruppur District at an estimate of Rs.362.20 crore - Administrative Sanction - Accorded - Orders - Issued.

### **Order:**

The Honorable Minister for Municipal Administration, Rural Development and Implementation of Special Programme has made an announcement during the demand for this department in 2018-19 that a Combined Water Supply Scheme to 708 habitations in Annur, Avinashi and Suler Unions in Coimbatore and Tiruppur Districts will be taken up for implementation.

2. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board has stated that the existing Water Supply Improvement Scheme to Tiruppur Municipality, 4 Town Panchayats and 412 wayside Rural habitations in Coimbatore and Tiruppur Districts was executed during 1993 and has served about 25 years and the existing Combined Water Supply Scheme to 249 Rural habitations in Annur, Avinashi and Suler unions and 48 habitations in Karamadai Union in Coimbatore and Tiruppur Districts was executed during 2004 and served about 14 years and requires replacement of pump set for ultimate stage. Further, presently 298 habitations are found as not covered with river water and scattered under the above 2 scheme area. The ground

water also found depleted. Frequent complaints arises that lesser supply is being received in the tail end beneficiaries such as Tiruppur Corporation and other nearby Town Panchayats.

3. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board has stated that based on the above announcement, it is proposed to formulate a new scheme by analyzing the existing water supply schemes to cover all the 410 habitations of the above 2 schemes and left out 298 habitations (708 Rural Habitations in 56 Panchayats) with revised prorata supply in three phases as detailed below:

He has further stated that,

- For Phase-I (the 8 Panchayats in Annur Union and 7 Panchayats in Avinashi Union), it is proposed to tap water from the existing scheme tapping at Pogalur Booster Station. Population for base year 2020, intermediate stage 2035 and ultimate stage 2050 has been projected as 83600, 105430 and 135230 respectively.

- For phase-II, (13 Pts in Annur, 4 Pts in Sultur and 16 Pts in Avinashi) it is proposed to tap water from the existing scheme sump at Vellikuppampalayam through 2 separate pumping mains. Population for base year 2020, intermediate stage 2035 and ultimate stage 2050 has been projected as 138680, 168230 and 208790 respectively.
- For Phase-III, (8 Panchayats in Avinashi and bulk provision to Tiruppur), enhanced water supply proposed with a new source for the additional required quantity of 11.136 MLD by regrouping and bulk supply to 165 habitations in 10 Village Panchayats in Tiruppur Union. For 8 Panchayats in Avinashi Union Population for base year 2020, intermediate stage 2035 and ultimate stage 2050 has been projected as 76040, 112380 and 164980 respectively. For bulk supply to Tiruppur Union, population for base year 2020, intermediate stage 2035 and ultimate stage 2050 has been projected as 59890, 89350 and 133830 respectively.

4. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board has informed that the estimate cost of the above project is Rs.393.16 crore to install and Rs.6.178 crore to maintain annually. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board has further informed that the Board in its resolution No. 2.9, dated 17.09.2019, has resolved to recommend to the Empowered Committee for recommending the above project to Government, with funding under NABARD RIDF-XXV (2019-20) and NABARD state share. The Empowered Committee in its resolution No.7.1, Dated 13.12.2019, has resolved to recommend the project proposal to Government to accord Administrative Approval at a revised cost of Rs.362.20 Crore to install and Rs.6.178 Crore to maintain annually with funding under NABARD RIDF XXV 2019-20 and NABARD State Share.

5. Based on the resolution of the Empowered Committee, the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board has requested administrative sanction of Government for the above project. The NABARD in the letter second read above, has sanctioned a loan assistance of Rs.29407.14 lakh for the above project.

6. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board have decided to accord administrative sanction for augmentation of water supply scheme to 708 habitations in Annur, Avinashi and Sultur Unions in Coimbatore and Tiruppur Districts with bulk provision to 165 habitations in Tiruppur union of Tiruppur District, at an estimate of Rs.362,20,46,000/- (Rupees Three Hundred and Sixty Two Crore Twenty Lakh and Forty Six Thousand only) to

install and Rs.6.178 Crore (Rupees Six Crore Seventeen Lakh and Eighty Thousand only) to maintain annually, with the following pattern:


