TWAD BOARD - WATER SUPPLY TO INDUSTRIAL COMPLEX AT
TUTICORIN - REJUVENATION OF THE PRESENT 20 MGD SCHEME
FOR Rs.181.50 LAKHS - PROPOSALS APPROVAL - ACCORDED.

ORDER:

The Water supply scheme for the Tuticorin Industrial Complex is functioning for the Past Twenty one years. The scheme was originally designed for 20 MGD. As the pumpsets have worked for more than 15 years, they lost their efficiency due to Normal wear and tear. Further the clear water pumping main of 1200 mm PSC pipe which is passing through salt Pan and laid above ground level for a length of about 765 m needs to be replaced due to the weathering action on the outer surface. Due to these facts the efficiency of the pumping system is reduced and the present supply is kept at 10.4 MGD.

The Government in G.O.Ms.No.154/dt.22.6.95 has accorded administrative sanction for replacing repairing the pumpsets and accessories etc. and permitted SIPCOT to deposit Rs.85.00 lakhs to TWAD Board to start the above work. But SIPCOT has not come forward to deposit the said amount.

During the discussion on 1.2.96 between Managing Director, TWAD Board, Managing Director, SIPCOT it was informed that SIPCOT would pay the above amount of Rs.85.00 lakhs in advance as loan to be apportioned to all beneficiaries based on the quantity of allotment, as per G.O.Ms.No.48/Inds/MIF-I/dt.28.2.95 and amendment issued in the Govt.Lr.No.29016/MIB-2/95-2/dt.19.10.95. The other beneficiaries have not concurred to contribute towards the capital cost.

4. In the meantime, the Chief Engineer, Southern Region, Madurai has submitted a proposal for the replacement and rectification of 1200 mm dia PSC pipeline at a cost of Rs.96.50 lakhs. The Board in its resolution No.122/dt.29.2.96, accorded administrative approval for the replacement and rectification work for Rs.96.50 lakhs,

and to execute the scheme as a deposit work after collecting the entire scheme cost in one instalment from SIPCOT (vide B.F.Ms.No.44 dt.5.3.96.).

The above two proposals approved by the Board are yet to be taken up due to the disputes in sharing of funds among the beneficiaries. This matter was placed before the Board meeting on 5.9.96.

The board in its resolution No.62/dt.5.9.96, after careful consideration, resolved to accept the proposals for the rejuvenation of the present 20 MGD WSS, Tuticorin at a cost of Rs.181.50 lakhs and further approved.

- i) to execute the proposals by TWAD Board from the funds available with TWAD and to get reimbursement from the Government.
- ii) to execute the two proposals and to collect proportionate water charges by incorporating the capital expenditure while suitably revising the water charges for the quantity to be supplied to various industries including SIPCOT and
- iii) to address the Government for approval of the above proposal.

Accordingly the Board accords approval for the proposals of rejuvenation of the present 20 MGD WSS, Tuticorin at a cost of Rs.181.50 lakhs and further approves to execute the proposals by TWAD Board from the funds available with TWAD Board.

The Chief Engineer, Southern Region, Madurai is requested to take immediate action to collect proportionate water charges by incorporating the capital expenditure, while suitably revising the water charges for the quantity to be supplied to various industries including SIPCOT.
