Thoothukudi District – Combined Water Supply Scheme to 90 Rural Habitations in Karunkulam (part), Srivaigundam (Part) and Thoothukudi (Part) Unions in Thoothukudi District with River Tamiraparani as source near Mangalakurichi at a cost of Rs.17.17 crore – Scheme cleared by the Empowered Committee – Administrative Sanction - Orders – Issued.

The Honourable Minister for Municipal Administration and Rural Development while moving Demand No.34 for the year 2012-13 among others has announced that Combined Water Supply Scheme to Udunkudi Town Panchayat and 368 Rural Habitations in 12 Panchayat Unions of Thoothukudi District with River Tamiraparani as source would be taken up for implementation during the year 2012 - 13.

2. The Managing Director, TWAD Board in his letter read above, has stated that as announced by the Honourable Minister a new Combined Water Supply Scheme to Udangudi Town Panchayat and 368 Habitations in 12 Unions of Thoothukudi District with River Tamiraparani as source are formulated in 3 different Combined Water Supply Scheme as detailed below:-

1. Combined Water Supply Scheme to Udangudi Town Panchayat and 30 Rural Habitations in Alwarthirunagari(part), Thiruchendur (part), Sathankulam (part) and Udangudi (part) Unions in Thoothukudi District, by tapping sub surface water of 1.51 MLD near Kurangani .
2. Combined Water Supply Scheme to 90 Rural Habitations in Karungulam (part), Srivaikundam (part) and Thoothukudi (part) Unions in Thoothukudi District by tapping 2.83 MLD of sub surface water near Mangalakurichi .
3. Combined Water Supply Scheme to 248 Rural Habitations in Koilpatti(part), Kayathar(part), Ottapidaram(part), Vilathikulam(part) and Pudur (part) Unions in Thoothukudi District by tapping 7.29 MLD of sub surface water near Seevalaperi .

Now, he has sent the Detailed Project Report for Combined Water Supply Scheme to 90 Rural Habitations in Karunkulam (part), Srivaigundam (part) and Thoothukudi

(part) unions in Thoothukudi District with River Tamiraparani as source near Mangalakuruchi, at a cost of Rs.17.17 crore to install and Rs.0.406 crore to maintain annually. The Per capita cost of Rs.3,558/-. The cost per 1000 litres is Rs.10.29.

Based on the recommendation of the TWAD Board in its resolution No.2.11, dated 12.07.2012, the Empowered Committee has accepted the above proposal and to accord Administrative Sanction for Combined Water Supply Scheme to 90 Rural Habitations in Karunkulam (part), Srivaigundam (part) and Thoothukudi (part) unions in Thoothukudi District with River Tamiraparani as source near Mangalapuruchi, at a cost of Rs.17.17 crore to install and Rs.0.406 crore to maintain annually and to implement with 100% Grant under Minimum Needs Programme / National Rural Drinking Water Programme. Accordingly the Managing Director, TWAD Board has sent proposal to Government to issue necessary orders to implement the above scheme.

4. Since the scheme has been cleared by the Empowered Committee, the Government accord Administrative Sanction for Combined Water Supply Scheme to 90 Rural Habitations in Karunkulam (part), Srivaigundam (part) and Thoothukudi (part) unions in Thoothukudi District with River Tamiraparani as source near Mangalapuruchi, at a cost of Rs.17,17,00,000/- (Rupees Seventeen crore and Seventeen lakhs only) to install and Rs.40,60,000/- (Rupees Forty lakhs and sixty thousands only) to maintain annually and to implement with 100% grant under Minimum Needs Programme / National Rural Drinking Water Programme.
